

Position Title: Assistant Professor of Double Bass and Jazz Studies, tenure-earning

Description: Teach Applied Double Bass and Jazz: teach a full studio of double bass majors and minors; recruit and maintain a studio of outstanding graduate and undergraduate double bass students; teach in the Jazz Studies curriculum (jazz theory, jazz performance practice, etc.); supervise recitals. Research/Creative Activities: perform as both a classical and jazz double bassist in important, peer-reviewed national and international settings; perform in recital on campus and in the community; perform in the UNL Faculty Jazz Ensemble; provide clear evidence of ongoing contributions to the national discussions of the double bass performance discipline in both classical and jazz contexts. Service: serve on faculty committees (School, College, and University); serve in relevant and appropriate professional organizations (examples may include American String Teachers Association, Chamber Music America, College Music Society, etc.); work in a collegial fashion with faculty, staff, students, and administration. Additional duties may be assigned by the Director of the School of Music.

Qualifications: Doctorate in double bass performance or jazz studies required. Equal expertise, facility, and enthusiasm in classical and jazz double bass performance required. Student recruiting expertise required. College teaching experience preferred.
