BASS RENTALS FOR THE 2015 ISB CONVENTION
Colorado State University, Fort Collins, June 1-6

A limited number of basses will be available beginning 4 PM, Sunday afternoon, May 31st for weekly or daily rentals on a first-come, first-serve basis; make your rental arrangements by May 1, 2015. Rentals must be returned by 4 PM, Saturday, June 6th.

Basses with a bag will be available at three levels:

Laminate (3/4 size, some 1/4 and 1/2 size basses available)	\$100/week \$40/day
Hybrid (carved top, laminate back and sides)	\$150/week \$60/day
Fully Carved (3/4 size, a few 5/8 size basses available)	\$200/week \$80/day

Several string choices will be available. If you specify the main focus of your playing, i.e. classical, jazz, etc, (primarily arco or pizzicato) we will try to find the proper string choice for your bass. We cannot guarantee you a particular string but will try to accommodate your request. You can also request a larger or smaller body instrument and we will try to accommodate your request.
