Description: For the first time ever, continuing education credit will be available to ISB convention attendees through Colorado State University's OnlinePlus. Credit is available to all convention attendees, but is designed for K-12 educators looking for university credits to help them achieve a lane change/pay increase in their school district, or complete professional development requirements. If you are a non-bassist educator, you may also attend the ISB convention free of charge as part of the ISB's educational outreach program. Those qualifying for free admission must pre-register using the enclosed paper convention registration form.

Submission of Written Work: Lecture, performance, and masterclass observation write-ups require the completion of one observation form per session (observation forms will be distributed at the ISB convention registration/check in desk). You must submit all observation write-ups to the registration desk by the close of the convention, or email a single pdf document containing all write-ups to adam.torres@colostate.edu within one week of the end of the convention to receive credit.
